Strategy Map

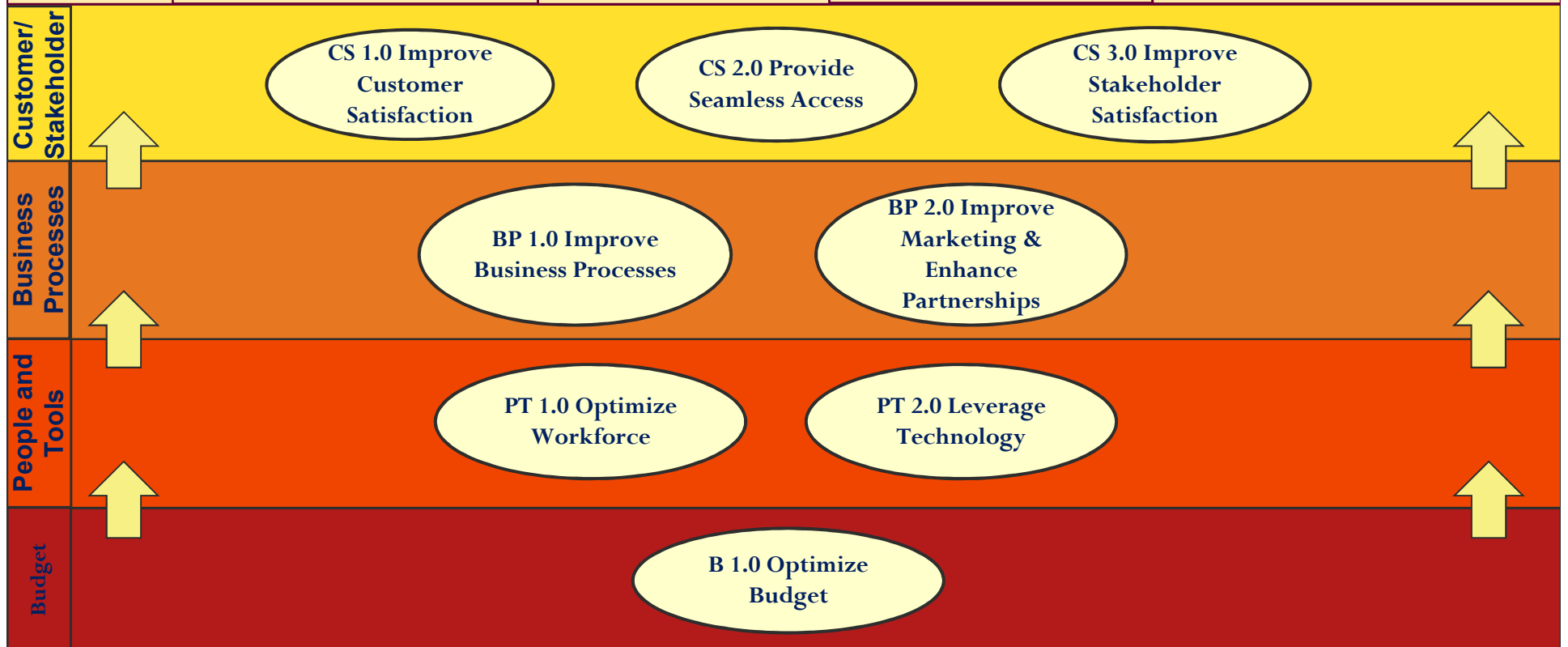

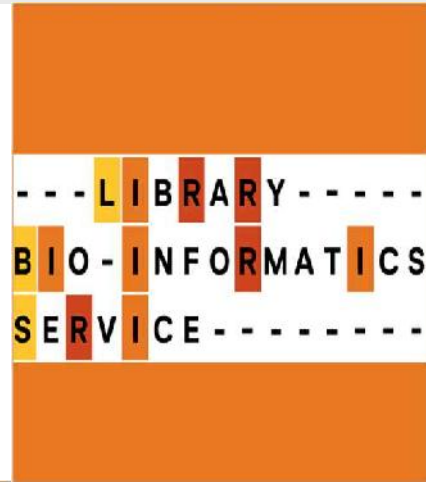
